It is a great pleasure for us to congratulate Professor Béla Gyires on the occasion of his 90<sup>th</sup> birthday. We admire his activity. He had a lot of tasks at the Lajos Kossuth University in Debrecen – he was, among others, head of the chair of Probability Theory, director of the Institute of Mathematics, dean of the Faculty of Natural Sciences. He obtained several prizes and he became a member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences. He started investigating linear algebra, the theory of matrices, then continued with mathematical analysis, and later on his main field became mathematical statistics and probability theory. theory" (World Scientific Publishing Co. Inc., River Edge, NJ) in 1993, at the age of 84, full of fresh and new ideas on the edge of pure and applied mathematics.
